The Arkansas Champion Tree Program is a listing of the largest known specimens of particular tree species in the U.S. state of Arkansas. It is updated every five years by the Arkansas Forestry Commission. The program was modeled on the National Register of Big Trees, started by the American Forests organization in 1940. The goal of Arkansas’s program is to record, heighten awareness of, and preserve the largest tree specimens in the state.

Fayetteville’s Champion Trees are: Wilson Park State Champion Dawn Redwood. Recognized in January, 2020, the Arkansas Champion Dawn Redwood tree measures 54 feet tall, has a crown width of 4 feet, and a trunk circumference of 9 feet for a Bigness Index of 172. The tree is located southeast of the iconic “castle” in Wilson Park.
