Liver metastases are most common with the following cancer types: ovarian cancer breast cancer esophageal cancer colon cancer kidney cancer rectal cancer lung cancer endometrial cancer stomach cancer pancreatic cancer skin cancer

Stereotactic ablative radiotherapy (SABR) is an alternative option for treating liver metastases. It’s sometimes referred to as Stereotactic Body Radiotherapy (SBRT) or CyberKnife. It is currently only available in a few specialist hospitals. SABR may be used if surgery and ablation treatment is not possible.

Liver metastases often referred to as “secondary liver cancer” which occurs in the breast, colon, pancreas, lungs, or GI tract of the person with metastasis to the liver. The overall survival rate for individuals with secondary liver cancer or liver metastasis is dependent on how much the cancer has spread, age of the patient, and overall immunity status.

~~What is the Prognosis for Liver Metastases?~~

A liver metastasis is a malignant tumor in the liver that has spread from another organ affected by cancer. The liver is a common site for metastatic disease because of its rich, dual blood supply (the liver receives blood via the hepatic artery and portal vein). Metastatic tumors in the liver are 20 times more common than primary tumors.

It can be hard to recognize symptoms and signs that cancer has spread to your liver. Many people don’t notice anything unusual to indicate that they’ve developed liver metastases. Some say they feel some abdominal discomfort or pain. You may also have one or more of the following signs or symptoms:

If this happens, it is called a secondary cancer or a metastasis. Secondary cancer in the liver happens when cancer cells spread to the liver from a primary cancer somewhere else in the body. Any type of cancer can spread to the liver. Common types that do include:

Secondary liver cancer, which is also called liver metastasis, occurs when cancer spreads from the primary site to the liver. It originates either in the colon, breast, lung, pancreas, or the gastrointestinal tract of the person.

Liver cancer is a cancer that’s found anywhere in the liver. The liver is a large organ at the top right side of your tummy. It helps you digest your food and removes toxins. Liver cancer can sometimes start in your liver (primary) or spread from another organ (secondary).

Metastases are the most common malignant tumors of the liver. The liver, lungs, and bones are the most common sites of metastases in the body. Liver metastases usually appear as multiple nodules, but may also appear as a solitary nodule (colon cancer is the primary that has the greatest tendency to result in a solitary metastasis).

Liver metastases are tumors that have spread to the liver from other areas of the the body. Cancer cells often have aggressive tendencies and will invade other areas of the body. They usually do so by floating in the blood stream and then replicating themselves in a new place.

So, liver metastases are cancerous tumors that have spread to the liver from other parts of the body such as the large intestine and rectum (colorectal), pancreas, stomach, esophagus, breast, lung, and melanoma. More often than not, these spread from organs such as the pancreas, colon, breast, lung, and GI tract.

If the cancer has metastasized, that means it has spread outside of the liver. The most common form of liver cancer is hepatocellular carcinoma (HCC). This cancer starts in liver cells called...

Liver metastasis is cancer that started in another part of the body and spread to the liver. It’s sometimes called secondary liver cancer or metastatic liver disease.
