The name is taken from its first two Hebrew words. With a holistic view of humankind, it prays for physical cure as well as spiritual healing, asking for blessing, compassion, restoration, and strength, within the community of others facing illness as well as all Jews, all human beings.

Prayers for people in need of healing, new mothers, babies and others. A “ mi sheberach ” is a public prayer or blessing for an individual or group, most often recited in synagogue when the Torah is being read. Because it is not an officially mandated prayer, there is a lot of room for creativity regarding whom to bless or how they can be blessed. Thus, there are mi sheberachs for just about any person in need of some divine goodness—most notably those requiring healing.

This prayer is a request to God for ‘ healing of body and healing of spirit ’ . Both are important for a person facing illness. The mi sheberakh can also serve as a cue to the community that we should be performing the mitzvah of Bikur Holim , visiting the sick when appropriate.

Traditionally, it is said in synagogue when the Torah is read, though in modern times, Mi Sheberakh is often said by professional health caregivers, patients, and loved ones at various times during treatment and recovery from illnesses.

The next morning, during the reading of the Torah, the Mi Sheberach prayer of healing was recited for “ Donald John ben Frederick ” and “ Melania bas Victor. ” Mi Sheberach is typically said for Jewish people who need healing by mentioning the mother ’ s name of the individual.
