Technically you can use almost any type of fabric to make a quilt but as a beginner the easiest fabric to work with is quilting cotton. 2 metres (approx 2 yards) for the backing fabric (we had some leftover after cutting to size) 1/4 metre (approx 1/4 yard) for each of 8 different types of fabrics (we didn 't end up using it all)

#### Quilting for Beginners - The Easiest Quilt Ever - Alanda Craft

What you need to do is unfold one edge of the bias tape so that you can see the raw edges. You'll line this raw edge up with the edge of your quilt. Starting on one of the long sides of the quilt around the middle, pin the raw edge of the bias tape to the edge of the quilt, leaving a 6 inch tail of bias tape.

Quilting stitches, whether sewn by hand or machine, hold the three layers of your quilt sandwich - the top, the wadding and the backing - together. As this is a beginner 's series on quilt making, I am going to look at straight-line machine quilting and you can find other types of quilting here at The Sewing Directory.

Take your quilt top to your sewing machine and take it slow, making sure you 're using your tape edge as a guide. I like to start my stitching in the excess batting and end in the excess batting. No need to backstitch because those edges will be concealed and locked in your binding.

### Straight Line Quilting (A Step-by-Step Tutorial for Beginners)

For some quilts the stitching starts within the borders of the quilt. Hand knot or microstitch to begin and end these lines of quilting to secure the thread tails.. Lines of quilting that begin at the very edge of the quilt, like the square diagonal set with no borders above, should start and stop several stitches past the edges of the quilt top.
